GRADE 9 GALA DAY- SUNDAY 25 MAY, 2008

The Members and the Committee of the Kanwal-Warnervale Rovers Football Club Inc cordially invite your Club to participate in our Grade 9 Gala Day to be held at **Kanwal Oval Pearce Rd. Kanwal on Sunday 25 MAY, 2008**

Our day is open to all Clubs and each Club may enter as many teams as they wish. The Gala Day will be restricted to a maximum of 24 teams. Teams will be drawn into 4 groups consisting of a maximum of 6 teams in each group. This will allow each team to play a maximum of 5 matches within their group.

A points system will operate on the basis of: a win is 3 points, a draw is 1 point, a loss is 0 points. At the conclusion of the Preliminary Group games, the first placed teams from each group shall advance to the Trophy Semi-Finals. A Consolation Series will also be run for the second placed teams from each group. All players will receive a suitable memento for their participation. The winning team will receive a suitable trophy, and the Semi-Finalists will receive a suitable medallion. (maximum of 12 per team).

An Entry Form and a full copy of the Rules & Regulations are attached for your convenience.

GRADE 9 GALA DAY

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All players must be registered with their Association In the under 9's age Group or be eligible to play in under 9,s All Players must be 9 years or younger as of the 31st December, 2008.
2. Teams entered for the Gala Day must be CLUB TEAMS ONLY. No Representative Teams will be accepted.
3. Each Team may consist of Up to (12) players, being (9) nine players plus (3) Interchange players. Should any changes to the nominated team be necessary on the day of the Competition. The changes must be lodged at the Official Table at least 30 minutes prior to the Scheduled Kick Off of that teams first match No player is to take the field who is not on the Official Team Sheet
4. Interchange players may take their place at any time during the game with the Referees permission. All changes must take place on the half way line. And a replaced player must leave the field of play before the interchange player runs onto the field. Time will not be stopped for an interchange to take place. However it is advisable to wait for a break in play.
5. Protests if any must be lodged at the Official Table immediately after the game is completed. Protests must be lodged with a fee of \$ 20.00 which is refundable if the protest is upheld. The protest will be handled by the Official Committee of the day
6. **Referee decisions are FINAL on ALL points of the Laws of the game. Abusive behaviour of any description WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. The Official Committee reserves the right to expel any players or supporters found guilty of such actions**
7. Games will start STRICTLY ON TIME. Any team not ready for kickoff time will forfeit the match. A toss of the coin can be carried out by the Referee to decide which goal a team is to defend if necessary and who kicks off.
8. Games will Start & Finish by a hooter from the Official Timekeeper, there is no time off for injuries.
9. The Kanwal Warnervale Rovers Football Club Inc. reserves the right to refuse entries and/or ground admission.
10. Visiting Clubs shall not hold any, fund raising activities in or around Kanwal Oval
11. Teams must be suitably attired as per the Official Laws of the Game. All players must wear their Club Uniform. For teams with clashing colours an alternate strip will be provided at the Official Table with a toss of a coin deciding the wearer.
12. No responsibility will be accepted by the Kanwal Warnervale Rovers Football Club Inc. or any of our Club members for any injury to players, nor damage to. or loss of any property The Grade 9's Gala Day has been notified to, and approved by the Central Coast Football and as such is covered by Soccer NSW Insurance cover. Teams visiting from outside the CCF must obtain permission from their own Association and submit a SoccerNSW Sanction Form.
13. Entries allowing, the 24 teams will be drawn into 4 groups consisting of six teams each. Each group will be allocated a field to play their Preliminary Rounds. The six teams will play each other once for points. Teams will receive 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw, and 0 points for a loss. Byes if any are necessary will be worth 3 points, 2 goals and 2 corners. In the event of a forfeit, the scheduled opposition will receive 3 points for the win, 2 goals and 2 corners. If a team withdraws after already playing games in the preliminary games. Their previous opponents will have their results adjusted accordingly as if they too had received a forfeit.
(If 20 teams are entered, there will be 4 groups of 5 teams)
14. The Winner of each group will qualify for the Trophy Semi-Finals stage. The Second placed team in each group will qualify for the Consolation Semi-Finals stage
To determine The 1st & 2nd positions if points are equal is as follows in order: -
Equal Points the team with the highest goal difference (ie: Goals for less Goals against) will go through.
If still equal - the team scoring the most goals will go through.
If still equal - the team scoring the most corners will go through
If still equal - the team conceding the least corners will go through
If still equal - the result of the match between the two sides when they met in the preliminary game will be the outcome.
If still equal – The toss of a coin at the Official Table will determine 1st & 2nd positions.
15. Duration of all games: -

Preliminary Games	- 10 minutes each way
Half time	- 1 minute
Semi Finals & Final	- 15 minutes each way
Half Time	5 minutes

Due to the tight time schedules teams must be ready to take the field as soon as the previous game has finished.

16. In Semi Finals & the Finals, goals and corners shall count. In the event of these being equal at full time a further 5 minutes each way extra time shall occur with goals and corners again being counted. If the result is still a draw a further 5 minutes each way extra time will be played with a Golden Goal and a Golden Corner rule to determine the winner (ie: first team to score a goal or a corner wins) If still equal then a toss of a coin at the Official Table will decide the winner.
17. The Winners of the Trophy Semi Finals will advance to the Trophy Final.
18. The Winners of the Consolation Semi Finals will advance to the Consolation Final.
19. All matches shall be played in accordance to the Central Coast Soccer Association rules for U/9 Non-Competition games which includes:-

Playing on approximately a half size field

No direct free kicks, all free kicks are indirect.

Taking of corner kicks

The Off Side law shall be utilized.

The Goal Keeper has unlimited steps in the Penalty Area the six second rule does not apply, but goalkeepers are encouraged to not waste time with the ball.

GRADES

It should be noted that this is a non-graded Gala Day and all teams are drawn out of a hat to determine the groups, this could mean A Grade playing against E Grade and so on.

WASHOUTS
